Application of Grip-Lok Hydrocolloid for Umbilical Catheter Securement

Grip-Lok 2300NUCH Neonatal Umbilical Catheter Hydrocolloid stabilization device is designed to secure catheters made from silicone and other plastic compounds. The 2300NUCH holds the catheter upright without contacting the stump. *Neonatal Skin Care Practice Guidelines* state the preference for hydrocolloid adhesives on neonatal patients.

- Soft and flexible fabric design improves patient comfort.
- Provides superior securement for both horizontal and vertical lifting accidental line pulls.
- Simple to apply, inspect and adjust.
- Hypoallergenic, breathable and latex-free to reduce the risk of allergic reactions and skin irritation.

Prepare the skin according to the standard hospital protocol for dressing application.




Remove the Grip-Lok from the bottom release liner by lifting the fabric and top liner at the same time.



Place the Grip-Lok on the skin circling the umbilicus and remove the top liner to expose the adhesive areas.



Fold up to 90 degrees the semicircle of fabric and place catheter in the center of the exposed adhesive.



Fold up the opposite fabric to meet the semicircle and secure the catheter between the two layers of adhesive.



Upright catheter position is maintained by the Grip-Lok Neonatal Umbilical Catheter Hydrocolloid stabilization device
